AtlantiCare Hospice to host “Coping with Loss” support group

AtlantiCare Hospice will host “Coping with Loss,” a six-week support group for adults who have experienced the death of a loved one. The support group will begin Wednesday, April 23 from 1:30 to 3 p.m., and continue every Wednesday through May 28. It will take place at the AtlantiCare Health Park, Building 600, 2500 English Creek Avenue, Egg Harbor Township. The support group is free and open to the public, but registration is required.

The support group will focus on understanding grief and loss; factors that influence grief; coping resources; and the importance of taking care of one’s self.

Through a team of doctors, nurses, social workers, clergy and volunteers, AtlantiCare Hospice works with patients and their families to provide palliative and hospice care to those facing life-threatening illnesses. The AtlantiCare Hospice team provides grief support to family and loved ones. AtlantiCare Hospice is part of AtlantiCare Health Services.
