She is chairman of the Department of Psychiatry for ARMC and medical director of AtlantiCare Behavioral Health (ABH). Venditti has also been associate chair and associate medical director of ARMC's Psychiatric Intervention Program. She served as president of ARMC's medical staff in 2007 and as vice president of the medical staff in 2006. She has co-chaired AtlantiCare's Reward and Recognition Team and been a member of AtlantiCare's Best People, Best Workplace Team.

Venditti is an associate clinical professor in the Department of Psychiatry at the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey (UMDNJ) Robert Wood Johnson Medical School. She was also director of the Affective Disorders Unit at the Belmont Center for Comprehensive Treatment in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, which is part of the Albert Einstein Health Network.
