ARMC holds seventh annual “Joints in Motion” walk

More than 200 former patients strut their stuff at annual walk

More than 200 people donned walking shoes to celebrate their new joints at AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center’s (ARMC) seventh annual “Joints in Motion” walk Saturday, October 4 at the AtlantiCare Health Park in Egg Harbor Township. People who have had full knee, partial knee, and hip replacements at the Joint Institute at ARMC joined their families, friends, and the doctors, nurses, physical therapists and other hospital staff who treated them at the annual event. Former patients included those who had surgery seven years ago and those who have had surgery as recently as two months ago.

In 2008, the Joint Institute at ARMC earned Disease-Specific Care Certification for total hip and knee replacements from the Joint Commission. The Joint Commission gave ARMC its Gold Seal of Approval™ for meeting stringent standards and providing the highest quality of care.
